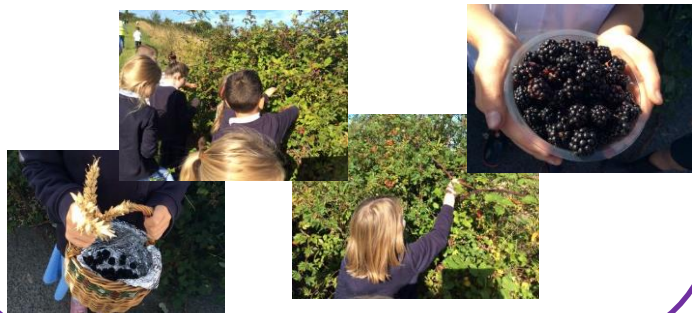

Data Collection and Consent Forms

Your children will be coming home with a data collection form today. We send a new form home with every child at the beginning of each autumn term. These are very important forms for the school as they enable us to keep up to date with any changes to home addresses, contact details of parents or medical conditions of the children.

Even if there have been no changes since last year please could you complete the form for each of your children and return it to school by the end of next week.

There will also be several consent forms delivered to your Parentmail accounts. Each year we must ask for consent to be able to take your children on school trips, administer medication and to be able to take and display/use photographs. Please read each form carefully and answer each section. The photograph and video consent form has several options, so please do answer all questions on this form when you receive it.

PE Reminder

Please can we remind parents that the PE Kit is a white round neck t-shirt and navy blue or black shorts, or joggers, plus trainers. Navy blue sweatshirts are permitted for PE during the colder weather. Also, long hair must be tied back during PE sessions for safety reasons. Children with pierced ears will need to ensure they can remove their stud earrings independently for PE and Swimming sessions. If unable to remove independently, they will need to be removed before the school day. Consideration will be given for 6 weeks after new piercings.
