Isla N- Helping everybody and practising my handwriting.

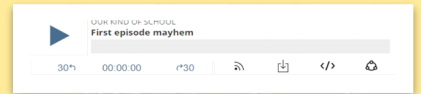
Jessica- Making pop-up Easter cards.
