



Chairs Report 2024-2025

Aims of FOSS:

- To enhance education of pupils in school by developing relationships between staff and parents and others associated
 with school
- To engage in activities and provide facilities or equipment which supports the school education of the pupils.

Committee history:

Used to be a very successful committee but after covid it naturally fizzled out.

A few parents picked up FOSS in 2022 and ran some low key events, just to start it back up again and keep it ticking over.

In January 2024, Lydia took over and has been in the process of getting things up to date and set up again (online banking, SUMUP, charity commission etc) with the support from Emma Fisher, as the liaison with school at the time.

In September 2024, a new committee was formed along with class reps/class WhatsApp groups. Many new events were introduced, purchases made for school and a successful first year all together.

Highlights of the past year:

- Managed to raise a huge profit of £8711 from events
- Used the Sum Up successfully (cashless events / convenience.)
- Used online platforms for selling tickets. (Track sales / easy to use / contactless.)
- Having a Treasurer
- Communicated well with parents about upcoming events through WhatsApp and Facebook page.
- Class reps enabled queries to be answered promptly
- Completed the Forest School area with outdoor learning canopy + equipment in addition to the Tipi from the previous year.
