Dear Parents/Carers,

We're very excited to welcome you to the Bumble Bees for Year 1! We hope everyone had a lovely Summer and got to enjoy some sunshine. On the back of this letter is an overview of what we will be covering this term.

This half term we will have PE on a Wednesday and children will need to be wearing their PE kits to school.

After having great success across the school last year with the ReadWriteInc phonics program we will be continuing to use this for our phonics teaching. The children are heard reading every day as part of the phonics session so this will not be recorded in their reading records. If you see an adult from school has written in your child's reading record this is an extra reading session. We are sure Mrs Fisher has said the same in Reception but we cannot express enough the importance of daily reading at home, even though your child has already read the book at school this builds the important skills of fluency and speed. A final note on reading, during the first few weeks your child may come home with a book they've had in Reception this is due to starting each colour band at the beginning after 6 weeks off but please be assured they will be onto new books soon.
